We are seeking to expand research in basic cellular mechanisms and signaling pathways, with an emphasis on those having demonstrable clinical relevance or translational impact. We are interested in a wide range of research interests in pharmacology, with a particular emphasis in the areas of chemical biology, pharmacogenomics, cellular metabolism, metabolomics, drug discovery, and systems pharmacology. Candidates should demonstrate a high level of research productivity and the ability to secure external funding. Candidates will be expected to develop an internationally recognized extramurally funded research program and to be committed to the education mission of the Department. Women and underrepresented minorities are particularly encouraged to apply.

Successful candidates will have a laboratory in newly renovated space at CUIMC. Faculty in the Department of Molecular Pharmacology and Therapeutics are associated with the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences, hold membership in numerous Institutes and Centers such as the Naomi Berrie Diabetes Center, The Institute of Human Nutrition, Herbert Irving Comprehensive Cancer Center, and the Motor Neuron Center, and have the opportunity to interact with faculty at Columbia University's Morningside and Manhattanville Campuses.
