In addition, a panel discussion with representatives from industry, academic and FDA will describe emerging opportunities for research partnerships in pharmacogenomics. This event is intended for a diverse range of scientists across multiple sectors who are interested in learning about the latest research in pharmacogenomics and precision medicine.

Importantly, this meeting is intended to present new opportunities for collaborative research and access to innovative resources to advance research in basic and translational pharmacogenomics.
